The goal is to decrease the risk of falls through greater strength and balance. Led by certified instructor Sinëad Farrell (pronounced Shi-NAY), the class is open to adult men and women. Exercises can be done sitting or standing. Wear closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothing. A donation of \$2.50 - \$5.00/session is suggested.
