It's school kit time!

Why school supplies? To the children who receive School Kits, **these supplies mean the difference between getting an education or not.** Public school is usually free, but in the places where LWR works, even a few required supplies like pens and paper may be more than many families can afford. You can help by collecting items for the kits. Collection dates: July through September 30
Needed for each kit:

- Four 70-sheet notebooks of wide or college-ruled paper approximately 8" X 10½"; *no loose-leaf paper*
- One pencil sharpener
- One 2½" eraser
- One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- One blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers
- Five black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink)
- One box of 16 or 24 Crayola crayons (other brands melt)

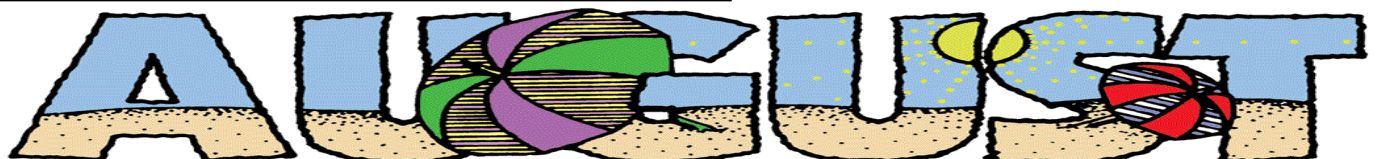

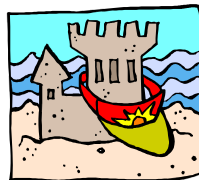
